A LACK OF CHARACTER

In America today, we are witnessing a disturbing increase in crime among adolescents, especially crimes that lead to imprisonment. Character and value training is sadly lacking among today's youth.

HOW CAN CUC HELP?

The Rock of Ages Character Under Construction program consists of over 185 lessons targeting specific missing character traits lacking in many of our youth today. Lessons deal with topics such as Honesty, Citizenship, Trustworthiness, Respectfulness, Forgiveness, Responsibility and Friendships..

HOW EFFECTIVE ARE THE LESSONS?

Character Under Construction lessons are designed to be taught in classroom settings to any audience. The lessons comply with governmental guidelines, and are neutral, objective and academic in nature.

Student participation benefits include increased rapport with teachers and other students. Schools have reported a significant decrease in necessary punitive behaviors for Character Under Construction students. Additionally, a reduction in student bullying incidents and disrespectful communication from students toward faculty and staff is often visible shortly after students begin the program.

4th AND 5th GRADE LESSONS

There are over thirty lessons for the 4th and 5th grades that are specifically designed to make students "stop and think" about their choices. Some key lesson titles are: Rebellion, Forgiveness, Gaining Respect and Etiquette.

MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL

Character Under Construction lessons are designed with anti-bullying themes and complement core values. With over sixty lessons on topics like Respect, Trustworthiness and Honesty, everyday life is exemplified and illustrated. The secret to the success of these lessons is that they are practical and easily understood. Lessons for the middle school and high school students include:

FAQ's

1. How much does this program cost?
Answer: It is free to all schools.
2. How much time is needed to conduct classes?
Answer: K-3rd grade is usually 20 minutes.
Middle and High School is 45 minutes.
3. Who teaches the lessons?
Answer: We supply the teachers free of charge and submit background checks.
4. Is this a religious class?
Answer: No, Character Under Construction is entirely based on students being exposed to character training that provides them with the ability to make positive decisions and have respectful interactions with their peers and adults to avoid life choices that negatively affect them beyond their youth.
